- *Clubhouse Effective March 1, 2023 residents will be required to sign an application form and pay a \$50 cleaning deposit before private use. The clubhouse must be cleaned, trash removed and furniture returned to the original placement on the day of use. Once approved, the cleaning deposit will be returned in full. You can get an application and pay the deposit to Esther Waters (Unit 220).
